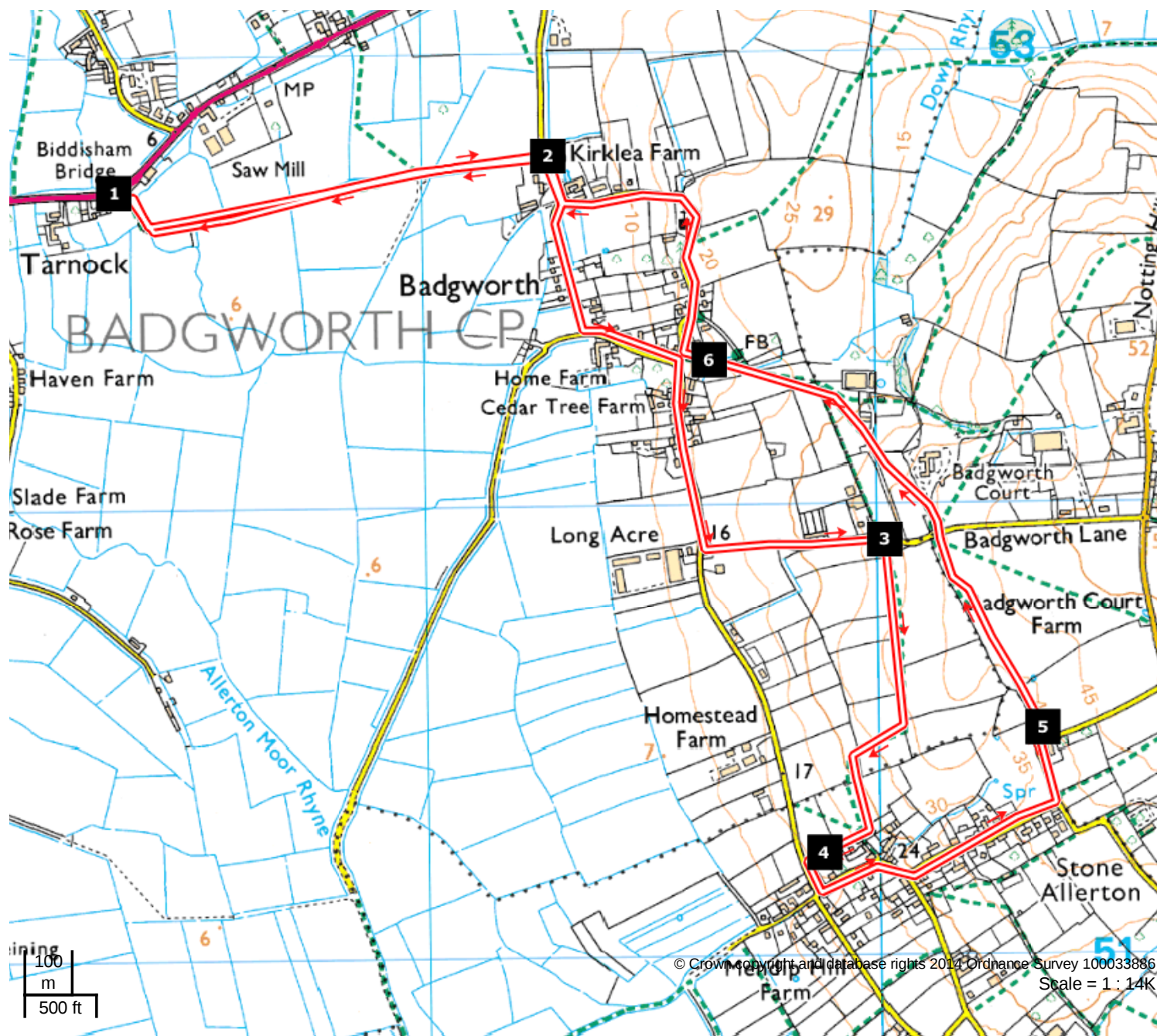

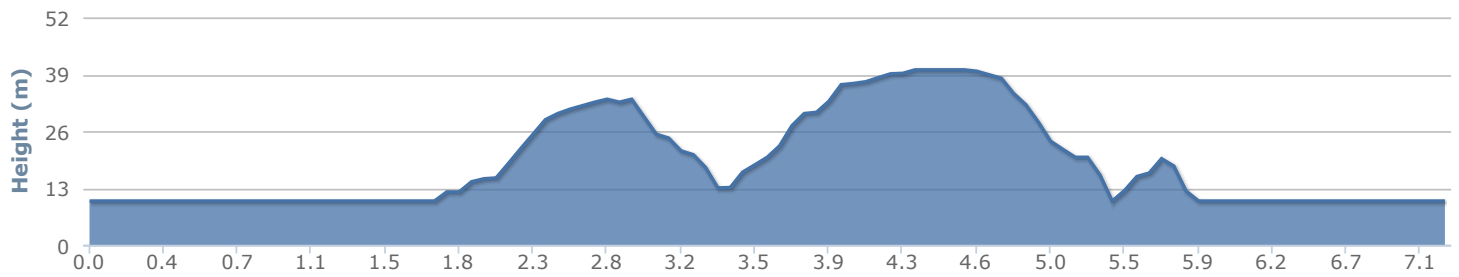
A circular walk passing through the villages of Badgworth & Stone Allerton

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Starts at

Lay-by at Biddisham Bridge on A38 just past the Biddisham turn when travelling south from Lower Weare.

Ends at

Lay-by at Biddisham Bridge on A38 just past the Biddisham turn when travelling south from Lower Weare.

Getting there

The starting point is on the main A38 road between Lower Weare and Rooks Bridge.

Route instructions

[1] Cross stile on left hand side of lay-by and go across small field to gate opposite. Pass through gate and turn left and proceed to wooden bridge, which cross into next field. Go straight ahead across field to reach point where hedge from left turns left to form field boundary. Follow hedge on left passing into next field and proceed onwards with hedge on left. At corner of field turn left to cross stile and then immediately turn right to reach a further stile in corner of field a short distance ahead. Cross stile and then continue straight ahead with hedge on right to reach a gate which pass through to reach T-junction with road ahead.

[2] Turn right and follow road passing Kirklea Farm on left and Home Farm and Cedar Tree Farm both on right. After passing Cedar Tree Farm turn left at next junction and proceed along road until a bungalow is reached on right.

[3] Turn right onto the path running along the side of the bungalow, which goes through a gate into a field. Keeping hedge on right cross this field and the next one to reach a stile in the corner. Cross stile and then turn right to head across two fields to reach a gate exiting onto a road.

[4] Pass through gate and turn left. At 'T'-junction turn left to pass through the village of Stone Allerton. The road through the village bears right after approx. 200yds and shortly after passing this turn left at junction and go onwards to T-junction. Turn left at junction and follow road to right hand bend. At bend cross stile into field by second gate.

[5] Keeping hedge on left proceed across two fields to reach road. Cross road to road into Badgworth Court and then in a short distance turn left through high (deer proof) kissing gate into a field. Proceed diagonally to the left across the field to pass through another deer proof kissing gate. Continue across next field in same diagonal direction to reach a stile in the hedge. Cross stile into next field and then head across field diagonally to left to reach a stile leading into a small football field. Proceeding in same direction walk on to pass hall on right and then exit into road.

[6] Turn right and follow road through village houses and out past church to reach road junction at Kirklea Farm. Turn right at junction and then retrace outward route from waypoint 2 above.
