

Nether Stowey, Pinnacle Hill, Peadon Farm & Durborough

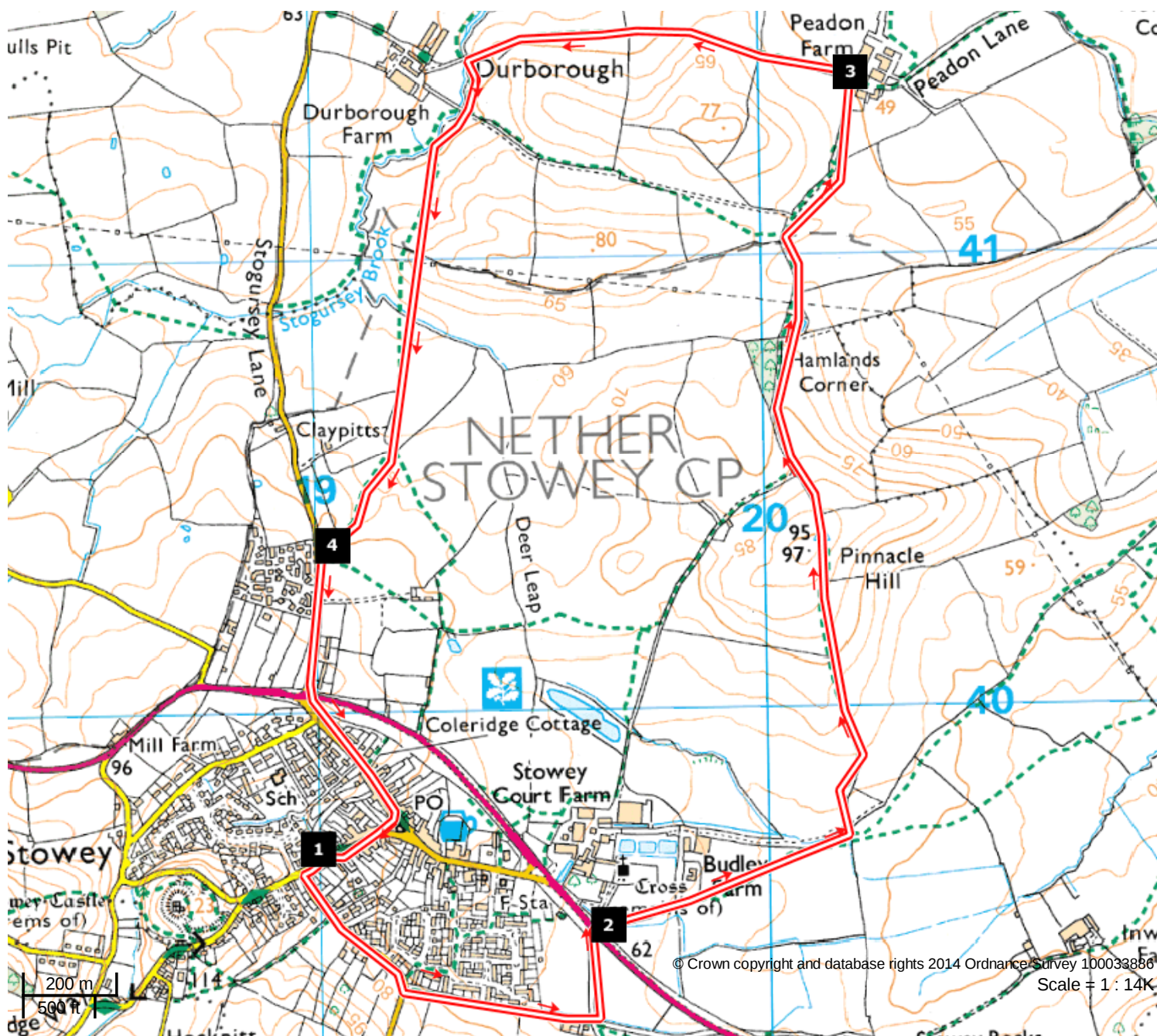

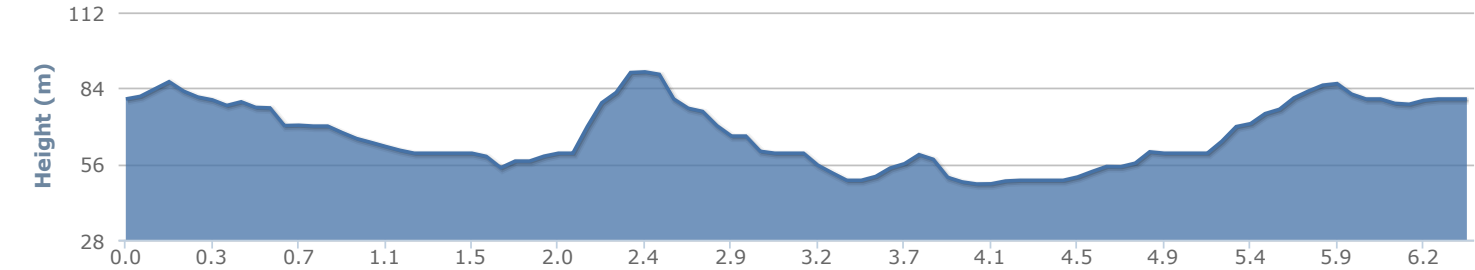

Getting there

Nether Stowey is 8 miles west of Bridgwater on the main A39 road going to Minehead. On approaching Nether Stowey follow signs into the village. In village centre turn left by the clock tower into Castle Street. The Library car park will be found on the right towards the top of the street.

There are pubs and shops in Nether Stowey. There are public toilets at the car park.

Route instructions

[1] Turn right out of the car park and walk up Castle Street turning first left into South Road. Follow South Road to point where it turns sharp right to go up a hill. On this corner turn left through a gate onto a footpath which runs behind houses on the left and fields on the right. Follow path to its end at New Stowey Farm. Turn left onto the farm access road and follow it a short distance to reach the by-pass.

[2] Cross over the by pass with great care and walk up the road leading to a farm on the opposite side. Pass the church on the left and on reaching a bend go ahead through a gate into a field. Follow path along the fields' edge with the hedgeline on the left. On reaching the corner of the field exit sharp left over a stile into a track. Cross straight over the track to a stile which cross. Follow the path up the right side of the field to reach the top of Pinnacle Hill. From the top of the hill continue in the same direction through fields to reach Peaddon Farm.

[3] Turn left at farm to follow a track going towards Durborough Farm. On approaching farm turn left on the first path on left running alongside a stream on the right. The path shortly runs ahead across the field to gate uphill ahead. Pass through the gate and continue in same direction downhill to reach a stile in the hedge. Cross the stile and head for hedge opposite where it turns right. On reaching the hedge corner go ahead following the hedge on the right to reach a gate. Pass through the gate and then follow path along field edge with hedge on right. On reaching a stile exit into a lane.

[4] Turn left into lane and follow it to traffic lights. Cross the by-pass with great care and go straight ahead into Lime Street. Follow Lime Street to the centre of the village by the clock. Turn right here and follow Castle Street back to the car park.
